The Start Ref will have a course crew/jury radio and a ski patrol radio.

Any licensed coach, crew or jury can call in ski patrol.

The number for ski patrol is 911 at all Summit areas.

The aid room at West is skiers Right of the base Lodge. Ground transport to Issaquah or Bellevue for injuries.

Ground or air transport to Harborview for more serious injuries.

There will be a 50 second intervals between the first 3 racers, then 30 second for all subsequent racers.

The course will be cleared bottom up. Before forerunners, and after any stop starts. Bib one will follow the last forerunner at 50 seconds.
