Team Alpental Snoqualmie (TAS) is a premier alpine ski racing program in the Pacific Northwest. We offer the highest level of physical training, professional staff and positive motivation to help aspiring young athletes achieve their racing potential. TAS provides opportunities for athletes to develop racing skills, alongside life skills, both of which are fundamental to the growth of a well-rounded, maturing athlete.

#### WHAT MAKES TAS SPECIAL

Founded over 40 years ago, our program helps young skiers grow both on and off the slopes with athletes starting as early as age 7 and going all the way through our Junior program at age 18. We are proud of the balance TAS provides in producing outstanding skiers who have developed a true love and respect for their sport, the competition, and the beautiful environments in which they race. TAS athletes thrive on winning but value sportsmanship and are coached how to win gracefully and to accept and learn from defeat.

TAS athletes have excelled at all levels of ski racing and industry - Debbie Armstrong, Olympic Gold Medalist at Sarajevo in 1984, got her racing start with TAS. Yina Moe-Lange raced in the 2010 Vancouver Olympics. For the past five years TAS has won team and individual titles including U12 Women's Cascade Cup, U12 Men's Cascade Cup, U14 Women's Buddy Werner, and numerous U18 National titles won by former TAS athlete Anna Mounsey.

#### 2021-2022 SEASON SPONSORSHIP

• TAS hosts 3-4 races every season which attract up to 300 athletes, coaches and parents per event.

• TAS Vehicles transport athletes across 15,000 miles of roads in the Pacific Northwest, California, Utah and Canada every Winter.

• Race Bibs are produced every 2 years or as needed.


