

## **Webb Moffett Safety Plan Ladies'/Men's SL & GS**

Call 911 in case of any emergency.

All Jury, officials, and coaches are required to have a US Ski & Snowboard license, background screening, and SafeSport training.

The Jury will check the hill and confirm the safety plan one day before the race.

Ski patrol is stationed at the top of the lift.

The Start Ref will have a course crew/jury radio.

Any licensed coach, crew, or jury can call in ski patrol.

Ski patrol can be reached at 425.434.6794. In case of an emergency, always call 911 first.

The aid room at West is skier's Right of the base Lodge.

Ground transport to Issaquah or Bellevue for injuries.

Ground or air transport to Harborview for more serious injuries.

There will be 50-second intervals between the first three racers, then 30-second intervals for subsequent racers; the last five racers could be run at a finish interval.

The course will be cleared from the bottom up.
